

WHAT ARE THE HAZARDS?	WHO MIGHT BE HARMED AND HOW?	WHAT ARE WE DOING TO MINIMISE THE RISK?
Working with others	Teachers and students	Distancing teachers from students in teaching rooms, maximising ventilation and staggering teaching times.
COVID-19 limiting personal exposure	Teachers and students	Social distancing, limiting sharing of instruments, wiping down instruments, wearing masks and shields where appropriate
Checking for symptoms	Teaching staff	Following the Government and NHS advice
Protection in communal areas	Teachers and students	Providing hand sanitizer, keeping doors open, reducing seating to 2 metres and asking for face coverings to be worn
Maintaining cleanliness	Teachers and students	Regular cleaning of instruments, shared areas and touch points, providing hand sanitizer and shields for teachers
Cleaning instruments	Teachers and students	Wiping down all instruments before and after playing, encouraging students to bring their own rather than share
Maintaining distancing	Teachers and students	Asking parents and students not to wait in communal areas, displaying signage, staggering teaching times
